Many more cows were required today with a ring full of buyers looking for grazers and slaughter cattle. A rip roaring trade from start to finish, with an entry of largely dairy cows all selling to the producers advantage.

761kg Lim cross cows from Lewis, Cwmann tipped the day at 215p/kg or £1636.15 in the lump. Another tested Limmie sold to 208p/kg for 611kg from James & Son, Awelfryn.

Black and White cows sold at 753kg to 196p/kg from Beynon & Partners (£1475.88) with Williams, Twmpath selling a 195p/kg for 750kg (£1462.50). Williams, Grove Farm sold their heifer 783kg topping £1464.21.
