Fewer lambs on the week, possibly due to a deadweight drop in some outlets and the Wednesday weather making it difficult to get the sheep in. Trade back slightly on the week but weight and quality continue to sell at premium prices. Lambs as light as 37kg crossed the £100 barrier with all lambs still averaging £103 per head throughout. Top prices saw quality lambs from Evans, Pantirion sell at 276p/kg and 273p/kg and £116 and £115.50 from Jones, Pantycetris.

We witnessed another cracking show of cattle and trade again did not disappoint. All types very well sold with the higher quality end looking very dear.

Top price of the day went to Dave Alcock for a 23-month-old Sim steer. A younger steer from the same home sold to £1290. Limmie's from Arwyn Jones to £1270 with dairy bred Angus from EM & ME Smith next at £1190. The younger suckler bred calves were a serious trade with yearling bullocks from Aled Griffiths selling to £1160. Plain, large-framed BB's from GE Davies & Son to £1145. 11-month-old Charolais feeding bulls to £1130 with younger dairy bred Lims at £1090. Best of the weaned calves saw BRB steers from Jones Partners, Bronwion selling to highs of £955.

A quality BRB again from Jones Partners topped the heifers at £1380, with a Limmie from the same home to £1275. 31-month-old Heifer from Marc Jenkins sold to £1260 with dairy bred Hereford's from Mark Robb next at £1200. Plenty of heifers over the £1100 mark today with Dai Parcmawr selling the best of his run to £1170.
